

SANTA CLAUS GIFT BOWL



Materials:

Yarn: approx. 90 g yarn (320m/100g) – black, red, yellow

Measurements: 6 inches (15.5 cm) diameter and 5 inches (12.5 cm) height.

Hook: 4 mm crochet hook (US size 6)

Notions: tapestry needle; scissors

Symbol Key:

st – stitch; sts – stitches

sl st – slip stitch

ch1 – chain 1 (the number indicates how many stitches to chain)

sc1 – single crochet 1 (the number indicates how many stitches to crochet)

tr – triple crochet also called a treble crochet (*learn how to make it at the end of the pattern*)

sc2tog – single crochet 2 stitches together (*learn how to make it at the end of the pattern*)

Bowl



With two strands of black yarn start with a slipknot.

ch4. Join with a sl st to the first chain.

Round 1:
ch1. sc8 into the ring. Join with a sl st to the first st.



Begin each following round with ch1 and sc1 into the stitch of the chain (ch1+sc1)

Finish each following round with a sl st to the first stitch.

Round 2:
ch1+sc1. sc2 in each st around. Join.

Round 3:
ch1+sc1. *sc2 in the next st; sc1 in the next st. Rep from * around. Join.

Round 4:
ch1+sc1. *sc2 in the next st; sc1 in each of next 2 sts. Rep from * around. Join.

Round 5:
ch1+sc1. *sc2 in the next st; sc1 in each of next 3 sts. Rep from * around. Join.

Round 6:

ch1+sc1. *sc2 in the next st; sc1 in each of next 4 sts. Rep from * around. Join.

Round 7:

ch1+sc1. *sc2 in the next st; sc1 in each of next 5 sts. Rep from * around. Join.

Round 8:

ch1+sc1. *sc2 in the next st; sc1 in each of next 6 sts. Rep from * around. Join.

Round 9:

ch1+sc1. *sc2 in the next st; sc1 in each of next 7 sts. Rep from * around. Join.

Round 10:

ch1+sc1. *sc2 in the next st; sc1 in each of next 8 sts. Rep from * around. Join.

Round 11:

ch1+sc1. *sc2 in the next st; sc1 in each of next 9 sts. Rep from * around. Join.

Round 12:

ch1+sc1. *sc2 in the next st; sc1 in each of next 10 sts. Rep from * around. Join.



Round 13:

ch 1+sc1.

Work through back loops only:

sc1 in each st around.

Join.

Round 14:

ch1+sc1.

Work through both loops:

sc1 in each st around.

Join.



Round 15:

Join red yarn and cut the black yarn.

ch1+sc1.

sc1 in each st around.

Join.



Crochet 8 rounds the same as Round 15.



Attach black yarn.
Crochet 2 rounds the same way:
ch1+sc1.
sc1 in each st around.
Join.

Attach red yarn.
Crochet 8 rounds the same way:
ch1+sc1.
sc1 in each st around.
Join.

Arms and mittens - make two



With two strands of red yarn start with a slipknot.
ch 12. Join with a sl st to the first chain.

Round 1:
ch1+sc1. sc1 in each st around.
Join.

Make 10 rounds with red yarn.



Attach black yarn.

Round 11:

Work in back loops only.

ch1+sc1. *sc2 in the next stich;
sc1 in each of next 2 sts. Rep
from * around. Join.

Crochet 3 rounds in both loops
like this:

ch1+sc1.

sc1 in each st around.

Join.



Thumb:

ch1+sc1. sc1 in each of next 7
sts.

tr3 in next st; sc1 in each st
around.

Join.

Crochet the next 2 rounds as
usual: ch1+sc1.

sc1 in each st around.

Join.

Next round: ch1+sc1. Sc2tog to
the end of the round. Join.

Finish with sl st through two sts of
the opposite end.



With yellow yarn embroider buckle to front of the bowl.

Sew arms at sides of the bowl.

That's all.

Triple crochet also called a treble crochet (tr):

- yarn over the hook 2 times
- insert your hook in the first st and draw up a loop (4 loops on the hook)
- yarn over the hook and draw your yarn through the first 2 loops on your hook
- yarn over the hook and draw your yarn through the next 2 loops on your hook
- yarn over the hook and draw your yarn through the last 2 loops on your hook

Single crochet two stitches together (sc2tog):

- insert your hook in the first st, yarn over, draw up a loop (2 loops on the hook)
- insert your hook in the next st, yarn over, draw up a loop (3 loops on the hook)
- yarn over, draw yarn through all 3 loops.
